Parity for Disability Announces North East Hampshire Cycle Challenge

Local charity Parity for Disability is holding a one-day 54-mile bike ride around North East Hants on Saturday 3rd May..

The event will be a great way to start off the bank holiday weekend as well as a new challenge to enjoy with friends and family. Participants can join as an individual or enter a team of up to four.

The 54-mile circular ride has been put together by qualified coach Donald Ashton of the Farnborough and Camberley Cycling Club.

Parity for Disability provides vital services for children and young adults with multiple disabilities in Surrey, Hampshire and Berkshire.

The event will start and end at Parity's Farnborough Day Centre (94 Whetstone Road, Cove, Farnborough, Hants GU14 9SX). Riders will set off at 10.00am and will need to complete the route by 4.30pm. Participants can reduce the sign-up fee by pledging to raise sponsorship. Individuals will need to pay a £50 fee but can pay £20 and commit to raising £100 in sponsorship. Teams of up to four can either pay an £80 fee for the team, or pay £50 and pledge to raise £100 as a team.
