### **RUSHMOOR MAYOR WILL GIVE £2,500 TO LOCAL CHARITY AS FINAL ACT**

As his last act in office, Rushmoor Mayor John Marsh will visit local charity Parity for Disability's Farnborough Day Centre on Monday 21 May at 3.00pm to hand over a cheque for £2,500.

Cllr Marsh raised the monies as part of his overall fundraising campaign during his mayoral year.

The funds will go directly towards maintaining the day to day operations of the charity which provides vital services and support to children and young adults with multiple disabilities in Surrey, Hampshire and Berkshire.

On his visit, the Mayor will meet with some of the severely disabled people who use the day centre, as well as Parity Chairman Paul Roper and Vice Chairman Owen Durrett.

Parity's day centres provide one-to-one support to each person who uses the centre, and creates individualised programmes to ensure their needs in education, health and personal development are properly met.
